Call for Applications for the London Protocol Engineering Master of Project Administration (LPEM) - 2024

Introduction:

The Graduate School of London Protocol Engineering Master of Project Administration (LPEM) at the Korea Institute of Ocean Science and Technology (KIOST) and the Association of Caribbean States (ACS) are pleased to announce the opening of positions for students from the Greater Caribbean region. This unique opportunity is designed to provide high-quality education in project management related to the protection and preservation of the marine environment, in line with the London Protocol and its Convention. Below, we outline the requirements and application process to participate in this Master's program.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be considered for the LPEM at KIOST, candidates must meet the following requirements:

1. **Nationality:** Be a citizen of a Member or Associate Member country of the ACS.
2. **Education:** Hold a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
3. **Work Experience:** Have a minimum of five years of work experience as a government officer in fields related to environmental, maritime, or project management.
4. **Language:** Demonstrate proficiency in the English language with an official certificate, such as TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) with a minimum score of 79 or its equivalent.

Application Process:

1. **Opening and Closing Date of Applications:** The specific timeframe will be announced in February 2024.
2. Interested candidates must complete the online application form through the website of the ACS. The application link will be available during the application period.
3. Applicants must provide the following documents along with their application:
 - Scanned copy of the Bachelor's degree.
 - Curriculum Vitae (CV) highlighting relevant work experience.
 - Official English language proficiency certificate.



- Letter of recommendation from a government institution, submitted through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of their country.
- Certificate of employment as a government officer (including military officers and National Universities).
- Personal statement (essay) explaining their interest in the Master's program and how they plan to apply the knowledge acquired.

4. Preselected candidates will be contacted for an interview.

Notification Date:

Selected candidates will be notified of their admission before July 2024.

Program Commencement:

The London Protocol Engineering Master of Project Administration (LPEM) program at KIOST will commence on [Specify the program start date].
