PROFESSOR: DIVISION OF LEGAL STUDIES**

The Division of Legal Studies at the Center for Research and Teaching in Economics (CIDE), in Mexico City, invites applications for a full-time professorship beginning in January 1, 2016. The Division of Legal Studies does have academic personal in both CIDE's two campuses in the cities of Aguascalientes and Mexico City. CIDE is a public research center specialized in the social sciences. The current research areas of the full-time faculty in the Division of Legal Studies include the following: public security and crime control, the sociology of law in Latin America, transparency and accountability, criminal justice, access to justice, judicial institutions, law and public policy, constitutional law, urban law, and law and economics. Qualifications and Profile Sought:

We are seeking candidates with a solid background in law and the social sciences and, preferably, with experience in qualitative methods applied to the study of legal institutions. Candidates should also demonstrate capacity to publish in leading journals and publishing houses in Mexico and abroad. The successful candidate must have been awarded his/her doctorate before beginning work and is expected to join the Mexican National System of Researchers ([SNI](#)). The working language at CIDE is Spanish. Candidates who are not fluent in this language are expected to develop the language skills required to teach courses in Spanish within one year. The minimum teaching load at CIDE is two courses per year.

Application Guidelines:

The application submission deadline is October 30, 2015. Late submissions will not be accepted. Submissions will be reviewed in the order in which they are received and a list of the finalists selected by the faculty of the Division of Legal Studies will be published on November 6, 2015. In the following weeks, shortlisted candidates will be asked to meet with faculty and present their research plan. Results will be announced on December 11, 2015. - i) cover letter including the candidate's reasons for wishing to join CIDE
- ii) full academic *curriculum vitae*
- iii) *résumé* (maximum length: three pages)
- iv) research plan (maximum length: 10 pages)
- v) statement of teaching philosophy (maximum length: three pages)
- vi) copies of the two research-based texts (articles, books, book chapters unpublished drafts) that the candidate considers to be the most important and the most representative of his/her academic work
- vii) teaching evaluations (if available)
- viii) two academic letters of recommendation
